COMPLAINT

In violation of United States Constitution Ammendment #4, TEXAS DPS officer CORONADO and his team of K-9 search dog handlers conducted a thorough search of the interior of my Motor Home without my permission or a search warrant on Sunday, 04.MAR.2001. I believe that the fourth ammendment to the United States Constitution specificaly protects a person's right to be secure in their papers things and effects and that right shall not be violated without the due process of the law, without a search warrant issued by a judge based on probable cause of a crime in progress suported by sworn testimony of witnesses under the penalty of perjury.
